Quiz Bowl Results

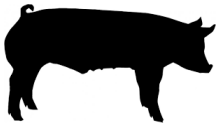
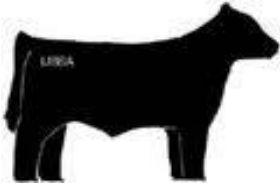
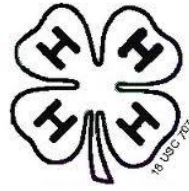
