

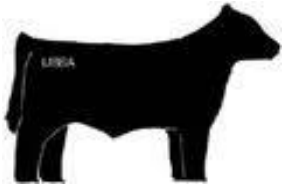

## **Donley County Jr. Livestock Show**

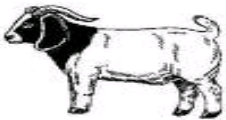


January 4, 2014- Stock Show Set Up Day @

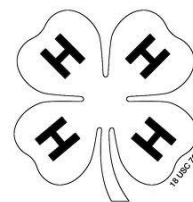
### **No Pass, No Play Reminder!**
