





This program is designed to develop youth and uses the sport of archery as its avenue. Students learn to use their bodies and minds to develop new skills to be successful. Along with minds and bodies, they develop character as individuals as they interact with other students and adults. There are opportunities that can last a lifetime in the sport of archery and the 4H Archery Program is a great way to get introduced to the sport. Students do not have to own their own equipment. All they have to do is show up and be willing to listen and learn. After some brief instruction, students are given the opportunity to shoot. As the student's proficiency increases new skills are introduced to hone their shooting.
