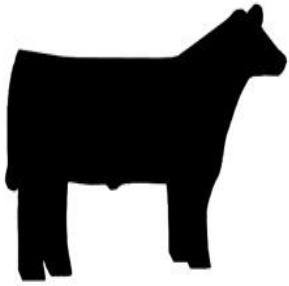

2017 District 1 4-H Leader Lab/POWER Camp

The 2017 Panhandle District 1 4-H Leader Retreat will be held on June 30th - July 2 at Plains Baptist Camp in Floydada. Activities will include the 2017-18 District 1 Officer Elections, educational and recreational activities, a dance, leadership initiatives, and leadership development sessions as well as wiring (everyone makes an extension cord) and safety workshops. All 4-H members are encouraged to attend. The cost is \$145 per member and this covers all expenses including meals, swimming, insurance, recreational facilities, games, projects and program expenses. Steer Validation June 27th



State and County steer validation will be held on June 27, 2017 from 4-6 PM at the Clarendon Vet Clinic. Exhibitors & parents who plan to exhibit steer projects at the county or major shows in 2017-18 must be present with steers to be validated on this date. The cost of validation tags will be \$20.00 per head. If there is a schedule conflict with this date you must contact Leonard Haynes prior to the date and make arrangements.

Steers will NOT be validated after June 30th, 2017 and will not be eligible to participate in any show!!
